: Momen Johnson / REPORTS ANAUTSIS

This letter is in response to letters dated 4-23-91 and subsequent follow-up conversations with Monica Johnson in Reports Analysis.

The issue that was flagged by the FEC concerned the dates of expenditures falling outside the stated time period for reporting. For example, the July Quarterly report, which includes activity from April 1 to June 30 may have had an expenditure dated July 16. This come from our effort to place an expenditure in the time period it occurred, but not necessarily was paid on. Many times something would be ordered or someone would provide a service for the campaign on a certain date, then we would actually pay them at a later date. We would then report the expenditure in the period it took place, without regard to when the check was actually written.

Continuing the example, let's say we had some copies made on June 20. The copy company billed us, and then we wrote the check on July 16. We would have reported that in the July Quarterly report with July 16th in the date column. In review of the reports in question, you will see that a majority of these off-dated expenditures come on the same day. Generally, the day we paid bills.

In conversations with Ms. Johnson, we have arrived at a new system which we will report both the date of the actual expenditure and the date of the check, if the two do not occur in the same reporting period. We will also only calculate the expenditure at the time of payment. This will hopefully alleviate any perception of oils-reporting. Ms. Johnson also indicated that an explanatory letter would suffice to remedy the situation with past reports.

The second issue was a missing schedule B which is enclosed.

The third issue raised dealt with in-kind contributions for candidates. As discussed with Ms. Johnson, we do not contribute to candidates through in-kind contributions. If you have any questions concerning these or other issues, please feel free to contact me at 530-544-0320.
