Dear Mr. Gibson:

The Committee for the 100th Congress was created in 1985 a multi-candidate political action committee (PAC) to support Congressman Charles B. Rangel's aspirations for a leadership position in the U.S. House of Representatives. We did not file the referenced reports because the PAC has been inactive since 1989 and, thus, had no activity to report for the periods shown above.

The PAC was active in 1985 and 1986, then became inactive in the late 1980's. The only activity by the PAC after the race for Majority Whip in 1986 was to use the remaining funds to provide contributions to members of the House in accordance with the purpose of the PAC until all of the funds were expended. To my knowledge, as Treasurer of the PAC, all of the funds were depleted at the time the PAC became inactive. I cannot explain the residual amount shown on the last report we filed other than to recall that I believed at the time that I had made an accounting error in previous reports which carried over to the end.


I am fully familiar with the history and operation of the PAC, and can assure you that the PAC's activities are terminated and there are no remaining funds.
