Dear Ms. Jones:

This is in response to your letters dated November 24, and December 1, 2004, concerning the above referenced reports.

Regarding payments from candidate's committees, reported on Schedule A, Line 15, please be advised that all payments received from federal candidate committee(s) for goods and services provided by this Committee, are at the usual and normal charge for the goods and services provided. With respect to Rent/Occupancy, our Committee charges candidate committee(s) the prevailing commercial rent for comparable rental space.

We have amended Schedule B to clarify the descriptions "Cashiering," "Mailhouse" and "Promotional Materials."

With respect to expenditures made for Cashiering, Letter Production/Mailing, Printing, Catering/Facilities, Postage, Postage/Shipping, Telemarketing, Cons/Prof. Serv. Program Mgmt-Direct Mail, Cons/Prof. Direct Mail Dev. and Fees-Direct Mail Processing as reported on Schedule B, Line 21b, please be advised that these expenditures are to support Committee activities, and are not made on behalf of specifically identified federal candidates.

Regarding making coordinated expenditures on behalf of Tom Daschle, Senate candidate for the 2004 South Dakota general election, enclosed is a copy of an agreement dated January 13, 2004, between the South Dakota Democratic Party, and the Democratic Senatorial Campaign Committee (DSCC) which designates the DSCC as the agent of the State party for making expenditures pursuant to 2 U.S.C. Section 441a(d), not to exceed \$74,620, on behalf of the Democratic nominee for US Senate in South Dakota. Also enclosed is a copy of a signed agreement dated May 15, 2003, between the Democratic National Committee and the DSCC designating the DSCC as the agent for the DNC for making expenditures pursuant to 2 U.S.C. section 441a(d) on behalf of Democratic candidates for the US Senate in the 2004 general election. This provided an additional \$74,620 for the Democratic candidate for US Senate in South Dakota.

Therefore, the total spending authority for coordinated expenditures, assigned to the DSCC as agent for the Democratic National Committee and the South Dakota


Democratic Party on behalf of the Senate candidate for the 2004 South Dakota general election is \$149,240.

We identified four "negative disbursements" on Schedule B, of the Amended July Monthly Report. Of these, two were offsets for in kind contributions reported on Line 25: one was a credit adjustment on the Committee's Bank of America credit card for travel related expenses. The credits are included in the memo entries for Line 21b. The remaining negative disbursement was for \$45.00 and represents a voided check. The original check was issued in November of 2003, but was never cashed. We issued a replacement check in March of 2004.

The excess contribution discussed in your December 1, 2004, letter was refunded to the contributor on July 19, 2004. The Committee reported in its August FEC report a negative attributable of \$3,000, for the contributor as a memo entry for Illinois Senate 2004, a joint fundraising committee. A copy of the appropriate page is enclosed for your information. The actual contribution refund was made by the Illinois Senate 2004 Committee

This letter sets forth in full the agreement between the South Dakota Democratic Party and the Democratic Senatorial Campaign Committee concerning 441a (d) spending authority on behalf of the Democratic Senate nominee in the 2004 general election for the United States Senate in South Dakota.

441a(d) Spending Authority

1. The State Party hereby designates the DSCC as the agent of the State Party for the exclusive purpose of making expenditures pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 441a(d) not to exceed \$74,620.00 on behalf of the Democratic nominee in connection with the general election for United States Senate in South Dakota held on November 2, 2004. The DSCC hereby accepts such agency.

2. In exercising its authority pursuant to the Agreement, the DSCC will comply with the limitations and other reporting requirements of the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended, and the regulations promulgated thereunder.

3. The DSCC will report to the Treasurer and Executive Director of the State Party the cumulative amount expended by the DSCC in connection with the general election under the delegation of authority provided under this Agreement

and any other information with respect to such expenditures which the State Party may need for compliance with the requirements of the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended, and the regulations promulgated thereunder.

This letter sets in full the agreement between DNC Services Corporations ("DNC") and the Democratic Senatorial Campaign Committee ("DSCC") concerning 441a(d) spending authority on behalf of Democratic Senate candidates in the 2004 general elections:

1. The DNC hereby designates the DSCC as the agent of the DNC for the exclusive purpose of making expenditures pursuant to 2 U.S.C. section 441a(d) on behalf of the Democratic candidates in connection with the 2004 general elections for United States Senate. The DSCC hereby accepts such agency.
2. In exercising its authority pursuant to the Agreement, the DSCC will comply with the limitations and other reporting requirements of the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended, and the regulations promulgated thereunder.
3. The DSCC will report to the Treasurer and Executive Director on the DNC the cumulative amount expended by the DSCC with respect to each candidate and any other information with respect to such expenditures which the DNC may need for compliance with the requirements of the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended, and the regulations promulgated thereunder.
4. Notwithstanding the foregoing, in the event that the DNC wishes to make such 441a(d) expenditures itself, the DNC may, by written notice to the DSCC reassume up to one thousand dollars of the authority per candidate delegated to the DSCC under this agreement. The foregoing shall not in any way limit any additional re-assumption of the authority by the DNC should the parties mutually agree to such, provided that the authority when requested by the DNC has not already been committed by the DSCC in allocation decisions on behalf of 2004 Senate candidates.
