In response to a April 1 letter from Mr. Christopher Morse (regarding Identification Number C00010322) the APWU is filing this amended report to re-categorize expenditures for T-shirts, buttons and bumper stickers distributed to APWU members as member communications, on line 21(b) of the amended report. The T-shirts and buttons were distributed to members attending the APWU Biennial National Convention. Members were encouraged to wear their buttons to the convention, and one day of the Convention was designated as T-shirt day. These efforts were directed to APWU members to encourage them to support a particular candidate. The bumper stickers were distributed to APWU members to be displayed on cars in employee parking lots used by APWU members. We are re-categorizing expenditures for yard signs as independent expenditures, and we are filing the required notices of these expenditures. The 48-hour report of these expenditures was inadvertently not made in a timely manner. The APWU was unaware of the 48-hour reporting requirement. We respectfully request that the penalty for failing to file the 48 hour report in a timely manner be waived by the Commission in this instance.
