This memorandum is submitted as a supplement to our July 31 Mid-Year Report to document the reporting of The National PAC's Administrative Expenses for the current election cycle.

As explained in prior filings, the PAC's leadership made a conscious decision to drastically reduce its overhead costs in order to maximize candidate support. Our administrative office on Capitol Hill was closed in the Spring of 2001, and our full-time support staff was eliminated. Our recurring operating expenses are now generally limited to the following categories:

Accounting Services
Direct Mail Production
Messenger Service
Office Supplies
Postage
Storage
Subscriptions
Telephone/Internet

While we literally operate on a shoestring, we find that we are able to achieve our support objectives and meet the expectations of our supporters. We do not anticipate a shift from this strategy in the foreseeable future. As permitted under the provisions of 11 CFR 106.6 (c), we elect to apply our Schedule H 1 ratio to all of our administrative expenses. We receive no reportable In-Kind contributions.
