
This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:

-Your report discloses memo Schedule A's totaling \$54,950 from the Arkansas Senate 2002, Iowa Senate 2002, Louisiana Senate 2002, Missouri Senate 2002, Montana Senate 2002, New Hampshire Senate 2002, and South Carolina Senate 2002, which appears to be joint fundraising committees. However, there are no corresponding transfers-in from these committees disclosed on Schedule A for supporting Line 12 of the Detailed Summary Page. Please clarify this apparent discrepancy.

-Schedule B supporting Line 28(c) discloses a disbursement to Greater Houston Community Foundation-Enron Workers Fund "in lieu of refund to ENRON PAC previous contribution dtd 10/9/01"; however, a review of your 2001 November Monthly Report (10/1/01-10/31/01) does not disclose a receipt of a contribution from ENRON PAC. Please provide further clarification of the original date of receipt of the contribution. If the contribution was indeed received by your federal account on 10/9/01, you must amend the November Monthly Report to disclose the receipt on Schedule A supporting Line 11(c) of the Detailed Summary Page: 11 CFR § 103.3(b)(1)

A response or an amendment to your original report(s) correcting the above problem(s) should be filed with the Federal Election Commission within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter. Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designation and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
