
Dear Mr. Evans:

I am writing on behalf of the Texas Freedom Fund (the "Committee") in response to questions raised by the Federal Election Commission (the "FEC") concerning information contained in the Committee's Mid-Year Report for the period January 1, 1999 through June 30, 1999 (the "Report"). Specifically, you raised questions concerning the "limited payments for administrative expenses" disclosed in the Committee's report.

The Committee's Report discloses \$31,027.04 in federal operating expenditures during the reporting period that included, among other things, payments for telephone service, salaries, office equipment and supplies. I understand from our conversation regarding this matter that the question raised in your review of the Report specifically concerned the fact that no rent payments were reported by the Committee. As we discussed, the Committee's operations are conducted out of an individual's home, as a result, the Committee has not incurred any rental expenses that must be itemized on the Committee's report.

We anticipate that this information sufficiently answers the questions raised in the FEC's December 15, 1999 letter to the Committee. If you need any additional information regarding these matters, please do not hesitate to contact me.
