This letter is in response to your letter dated August 8, 2008 to Kirby A. Thompson, Treasurer of the Equifax Political Action Committee. Your notice requested information regarding contributions made to two candidate committees. Those contributions are:

On my July quarterly filing, I reported these contributions having been for each candidate's primary election. This was a reporting error on my part. I reported the wrong election (primary) instead of the correct election (general). The contributions were made after their primary elections but before the general election. We intended the contributions for each candidate's general election.

To correct these two reporting errors, I filed an amended report for the July quarterly filing and on that report I took the following action:

- 1) For "Judy Biggert for Congress" contribution, I amended the original report with the correction changing the election designation from primary to general election.
- 2) For "Roskam for Congress Committee" contribution, I amended the original report with the correction changing the election designation from primary to general election.

I hope these actions are acceptable to you and the Federal Election Commission. Thank you for discussing the matter with me on the telephone earlier today. Your time and support, as well as, the support that the FEC staff has provided to me in the past are greatly appreciated.
