Dear Ms. Smith:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **An adequate response must be received at the Commission by the response date noted above.** An itemization of the information needed follows:

-Schedule A of your report (see attached) discloses one or more contributions which appear to exceed the limits set forth in the Act. 2 U.S.C. §441a(f) and 11 CFR §§110.1(d) and 110.2(d) prohibit a committee and its affiliates from receiving any contribution from another political committee or person in excess of \$5,000 per calendar year. However, the transaction description, "Transfer from Affiliated PAC," indicates that your committee may actually be affiliated with "RGC PAC". As provided for in 11 CFR §100.5(g)(2), affiliated committees are those political committees established, financed, maintained, or controlled by the same group of persons including any parent, subsidiary, branch, division, department, or local unit thereof. Affiliated political committees may make and receive unlimited transfers amongst themselves which are not considered to be contributions. 11 CFR §102.6(a)


If any apparently excessive contribution in question was incompletely or incorrectly disclosed, you must amend your original report with the clarifying information.

If any contribution you received exceeds the limits, you may have to refund the excessive amount. The funds can be retained if within 60 days of receipt, (1) the excessive amount was properly reattributed to another
