Dear Mr. Rasmussen:

On July 1, 1998, you were notified that a review of the above-referenced report(s) raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act.

Your July 7, 1998, response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.

-You state your committee has exercised "best efforts" in obtaining occupation and name of employer for all individuals who contribute more than \$200 in a calendar year. Please note that in order to establish "best efforts", a committee must provide the Commission with a description of its procedures for requesting the information and may also provide a copy of a solicitation. The committee should

- * make a clear and conspicuous request for contributor information in initial solicitations
- * make follow-up requests that do not include any additional solicitations (if necessary)
- * include a pre-addressed return envelope or post card with written follow-up requests


* file amendments to disclose previously unreported information

Please provide a description of your procedures in order to establish "best efforts."

If this information is not received by the Commission within fifteen (15) days from the date of this notice, the Commission may choose to initiate audit or legal enforcement action.
