The Yvonne House

The Yvonne House is a supportive living environment for women in alcohol/drug Recovery. It will provide a safe and nurturing environment for up to 6 women.

It uses the twelve steps and twelve traditions as the guiding principles.

It is named after Sister Yvonne from Blessed Sacrament and the community of Hope group which met on Saturdays there. Sister Yvonne was a wildly imperfect woman whose face lit up in delight when she saw us waiting for her on her porch swing for the Saturday morning meetings.

Women in Lincoln are currently put on waiting lists for treatment which can be six months long. Partners in Recovery feels we can help provide a place for women to recover. Recovery is about relationship. Relationship with a higher power, relationship with ourselves and relationship with other people. Recovery is about love and someone's face lighting up when they see you.

The house which previously was used as a drug house was in need of repair. It is being transformed into a warm and beautiful place by a small army of caring volunteers (72) who have donated 300 hours so far.

The Yvonne house is kind of a metaphor for change. It is a physical symbol of hope. So far, all of the residents of the Yvonne House have been mothers. The greatest gift we can give children is a parent who is in their right mind.
