I am writing to follow up on my letter to you of December 3, 2008, in which I requested the refund of an excessive contribution made by the Rock-Tenn Company Political Action Committee to Senator Chambliss' run-off campaign. Our contribution exceeded the permitted limits of a non multi-candidate PAC by \$1,200.00. For your reference, I have enclosed copies of my previous letter and the canceled check.

Following the initial request, I received a telephone call from a member of your staff and confirmed to her during that conversation that we would like for the funds to be returned to the RockTenn PAC. To date, we still have not received the refund.

Please note that we are required to report to the FEC that this is a debt outstanding to the committee and must continue to do so until the refund is received. I apologize for the inconvenience this oversight has caused you but would appreciate your prompt return of the funds.
