
Dear Ms Parks,

This letter is in response to the questions contained in your letter of October 23rd, 2002 regarding Victory 2002's July Quarterly report. I will address the questions in the same order they are raised in your letter.

1. You raised a question about a contribution listed in Schedule A for a C&C Construction Company. This entity is a partnership not a corporation.
2. You raised a question about a contribution of \$25,000.00 listed in Schedule A from Friends of John Tanner. This was a transfer of excess campaign funds by a congressional candidate and therefore did not exceed any contribution limits.
3. You raised a question about three transfers from the Democratic Senatorial Campaign Committee, which were not disclosed on the DSCC report. I have enclosed three letters from the DSCC documenting the transfers in question.
4. You have asked for a breakdown on Schedule H3 of transfers received from the Non-federal account. We have amended the report electronically to provide that breakdown.
5. You have asked us to amend the report by providing the complete address for each disbursement itemized on Schedule H4. We have filed that amendment electronically.
6. You have asked us to clarify certain descriptions of disbursements listed on Schedule H4 to show that "consulting" was "political management consulting" and to show that reimbursements/ supplies was "office supply reimbursement".

I hope that this response is helpful. Please let me know if you need any additional information.




