-Line 11(a)(ii) of the Detailed Summary Page discloses \$117,913.85 in uniterized receipts from individuals/persons other than political committees during the reporting period. Please clarify whether this figure includes any receipts from a single source that aggregate greater than \$200 in the calendar year. If this is the case, please amend your report(s) by itemizing the receipts on Schedule A supporting Line 11(a)(i). 2 U.S.C. §434(b)(2)(A) and (3)(A)

-Please amend Schedule B supporting Line 23 by providing the full name, address, office sought (House, Senate, or President), state, and congressional district, if applicable for each contribution made. 11 CFR §104.3(b)(3)(ii) and (v)

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered. Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply
