To Whom It May Concern:

This letter is in response to correspondence received by my office on January 4, 2008. The purpose is to address a difference of \$24,947 on our amended July 2007 Quarterly Report. In January of 2007, our PAC changed banking institutions, thus forcing us to redesign our direct mail program, along with other internal procedures. In this transition, it was our understanding that the new bank s software (Wachovia) and our PAC software (VOCUS) would be compatible, allowing us to import direct mail response data from Wachovia into VOCUS. By late August and early September, through the process of our yearly internal audits, we discovered that not all the data was transferring accurately. The next step was to comb through each individual receipt to confirm they had all been entered into our PAC database, which also produces our FEC compliance reports. As a result, we discovered receipts that had been collected by our bank, but were not being reported by the VOCUS software to the FEC. In order to remain compliant, we entered the missing receipts we found, and filed an amendment report.
