Dear Treasurer:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 2 items:

1. Please clarify your relationship, if any, with "International Union of Operating Engineers", which appears to be an affiliated committee. For further guidance on the question of affiliation, please refer to 11 CFR §100.5(g) and §110.3. If your committee is affiliated with "International Union of Operating Engineers", you should amend your Statement of Organization to check the "Affiliated Committee" box on Line 6.
2. Line 6 indicates that your committee's "connected organization" is "International Union of Operating Engineers". However, it appears this entity may be an affiliated committee. Please amend your Statement of Organization to clarify and disclose the official name of your connected organization (11 CFR §102.2(a)(1)(ii)) on Line 6, as appropriate.


Moreover, in accordance with 2 U.S.C. §432(e)(5), the name of any separate segregated fund is required to include the entire name of its connected organization. Committees may use commonly recognized abbreviations on daily communications such as letterhead and committee checks, however, your committee filings (i.e. Statement of Organization, disclosure reports and amendments) must reflect the official name of the connected organization, as well as any abbreviation, within its title. Please amend your filing to clarify this apparent discrepancy.

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
