My assistant, Annette Seidel, recently spoke with Ms. Alice Kang of the Federal Election Commission regarding the reporting of redesignated items. Ms. Kang informed us that all monies given for the 2002 Primary (regardless of whether they were designated to the House or to the Senate) are subject to the single \$5000 limit. Additionally, monies designated for a future election which the candidate does not make, should be refunded. According to our records, we cannot redesignate any monies and therefore request a refund of the \$3000 designated to the Runoff.




