Dear Mr. Brown,

In correspondence I submitted last year, I informed the FEC that the Cantor Victory Fund's 2009 disclosure reports would be filed on FEC Form 3X - instead of FEC Form 3 - per the FEC's request. See <http://query.nictusa.com/pdf/105/28991504105/28991504105.pdf#navpanes=0>. FEC Form 3X permits a committee to choose between quarterly/semi-annual filing and monthly filing. FEC Form 3 requires reporting on a completely different schedule: quarterly. There is no quarterly/semi-annual or monthly filing option for FEC Form 3 filers.

I had assumed that when the Cantor Victory Fund began filing FEC Form 3X, there would be no need to notify the FEC of a change in filing schedules. I based my assumption on the fact that I had already notified the FEC that the Cantor Victory Fund was changing reporting forms. That change necessarily required a change in filing schedule. Accordingly, another notification that the Cantor Victory Fund was changing its filing schedule seemed redundant. If the FEC nonetheless requires additional notification that the Cantor Victory Fund is changing its filing schedule, please accept this submission as confirmation that the Cantor Victory Fund will be filing FEC Form 3X on a monthly basis.
