This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:

-2 U.S.C. §434(b)(6)(B)(iii) requires that the supporting schedule for disclosing independent expenditures be signed by the treasurer and certified by a notary public. This is to attest to the fact that the expenditures were not made in cooperation, consultation, or consent with, or at the request or suggestion of any candidate, or any authorized committee or agent of such committee. Please amend your Schedule E accordingly.

-Itemized disbursements must include a brief statement or description of why the disbursements were made. Please amend Schedule E of your report to clarify the following description(s): consulting fee. For further guidance regarding acceptable purposes of disbursements, please refer to 11 CFR §104.3(b)(3).

-The Commission notes the repayment of the apparent impermissible loan received from your non-federal account. Although the Commission may take further legal action concerning the acceptance of impermissible funds, your prompt corrective action will be taken into consideration.

A written response or an amendment to your original report(s) correcting the above problem(s) should be filed with the Federal Election Commission within fifteen (15) days
