
In response to your letter dated August 1, 2008, we have received the attached communication from Philip Pearce, Custodian of Records for "People for Pearce".

Chevron Employees PAC (CEPAC) contributed \$3,000.00 on June 24, 2008 to the "People for Pearce" 2008 primary campaign for the retirement of debt. As a result of your August 1st communication, we contacted Mr. Pearce and he advised that the committee does have sufficient debt to warrant our \$3,000.00 contribution. Mr. Pearce also informed us that he has filed Form 99 with the FEC which explains the committee's current financial status.

Based on the information we received from Mr. Pearce, CEPAC believes the debt retirement contribution is permissible and will, therefore, not take any corrective actions at this time to obtain a refund or redesignate the contribution. If however, your records still indicate that "People for Pearce" did not have sufficient primary election debt at the time CEPAC made its contribution, please advise so that we can take immediate corrective action.

I apologize that my earlier email failed to make it to you. In reference to our telephone conversation about the FEC notice received by Chevron PAC about a primary debt retirement contribution to People for Pearce, I have filed a Form 99 with the FEC notifying them that there was in fact excess primary expenditures over primary contributions through June 30, 2008. This existing primary debt takes into consideration the contributions made by Chevron PAC and other contributors toward retirement of the primary debt. The primary debt was not reported on the 2nd quarter 2008 report, because it had not been outstanding for 60 days at that time.
