Dear Ms. Sinram:

The Commission's preliminary review of the report referenced above raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report. We have addressed each question below and/or have amended the Campaign Report to reflect our changes.

-Schedule A, Line 11a - To disclose occupation and employer information not previously reported. Changes reflected on the amendment e-filed 3/22/2008.

Our procedure for obtaining the occupation and employer for contributors is as follows:

- a) All written solicitation for contributions requests the contributor's full name, mailing address, occupation and name of employer;
- b) A computer generated letter requesting the contributor's full name, mailing address, occupation and name of employer is sent within 30 days after receipt of the contribution. This letter does not include material or any other subject of any additional solicitation, except to thank the contributor for the contribution. A pre-addressed return envelope is enclosed with each letter.
- c) If the information is received after the contribution has been disclosed on a regularly scheduled report, we will amend the campaign report to disclose this information.

-Schedule B, Line 30 - During July, August, and September of 2007, no employee devoted more than 25% of their time during a month on activities in connection with a Federal election.

-Schedule H3 of our report discloses 'Democratic State Central Committee of' as the name of account(s) for transfers received. The account name has been shortened to allow you to view the committee name as 'Dem State Central Comm of CA Non-fed.
