Dear Mr. Golden:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:

-Schedule A of your report discloses earmarked contributions. If the contribution passed through your committee's account, each must be itemized on the receipt and expenditure schedules, regardless of the amount. For disclosure purposes, the name and mailing address for each contributor must be provided, and where the contribution exceeds \$200, the individual's occupation and name of employer must also be itemized. Please amend your report accordingly. 11 CFR §110.6(c)(1)(v) But, if the earmarked contribution did not pass through your committee's account, you must itemize the same information in a memo entry on Schedules A and B. Please be advised that the entries should indicate that the contribution was passed on in the form of the contributor's original check and, if applicable, should indicate that the conduit's limits for that candidate were affected.
