The American Pilots' Association PAC is in receipt of three separate letters (RQ-2), Dated March 10, 2015. The letters request further information regarding balance discrepancies on the Amended December Monthly Report (11-01-13 - 11/31/13), the Year End Report (12-01-13 - 12-31-13) and the June monthly report (5-1-14 - 5-31-14). The following is an explanation of what happened during that time period. In June, 2014, our auditors were in our office performing our annual financial audit. The auditor reviewed the APA PAC reports and discovered that three checks had been omitted from the PAC reports in error. The first check was #3327, payable to Friends of Corrine Brown, written on 05/22/2013 in the amount of \$1,000. The next two checks were each written on 11/21/13, check #3342 was written to Pallone for Congress in the amount of \$1,000 and Check #3343 was written to Cummings for Congress in the amount of \$3,000. After our auditor had brought these three omissions to my attention, I filed amended reports which corrected these omissions. The contributions to candidates Brown, Pallone, and Cummings were all reported at that time on June 6, 2014. I use Fecfile and I understand that after a certain amount of time has passed, updated balances will only be reflected in my software and may not be corrected in the records at the FEC. According to my Fecfile records and the balances on record here at the APA office, there are no discrepancies and all starting and ending balances have been corrected and are in balance.

I hope this explains the differences between the original and amended reports.
