Dear Treasurer:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action. Additional information is needed for the following 2 item(s):

- 1. Your committee has requested that the Commission permit your committee to terminate pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 433(d) and 11 CFR § 102.3. Preliminary review of reports filed during the 2012 election cycle identified problems concerning certain information disclosed by your committee of which you were previously notified. Your committee must continue to file all required reports with the Commission while a determination is being made on whether to pursue these matters any further. The Commission will notify you when your request to terminate has been approved and the committee is no longer required to file reports with the Commission.
- 2. The loan payment(s) disclosed on Schedule B does not equal the loan payment(s) itemized on Schedule C. Each loan payment made by the committee must be itemized on Schedule B, regardless of the amount of the payment, and included in the payment to date calculation on Schedule C. Please correct this discrepancy and file an amendment to your report. (11 CFR § 104.3(b)(4)(iii))

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to

taking enforcement action. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
