Re: Corrections for 2002 Year End Report (I.D. Number C00282921)

Dear Mr. Morse:

I wanted to thank you for your prompt response to my inquiry of last week. I appreciate the assistance you have given in advising me on how to correct a discrepancy with filings for the Winston & Strawn Political Action Committee ("Winston & Strawn PAC") (Identification Number: C00282921).

In accordance with your advice, the Winston & Strawn PAC is amending its 2002 year-end report to rectify a discrepancy of \$4,152.43 in the cash on hand it has reported to the Federal Election Commission ("FEC"). As we discussed, the Winston & Strawn PAC's reconciled year-end bank statement indicated a balance of \$21,760.89, but its cash-on hand it reported to the FEC was \$4,152.43 more than this amount. As you instructed, the Winston & Strawn PAC has included this amount as an Line 21(b) disbursement on its 2002 year-end statement. Winston & Strawn PAC has taken such corrective actions in an electronic filing with the FEC dated February 10, 2003.

Additionally, per your instructions, the Winston & Strawn PAC has noted a negative disbursement for an outstanding contribution to the campaign of the late Senator Paul Wellstone that was made on October 21, 2002. Because the contribution check was not cashed by the Wellstone campaign, the Winston & Strawn PAC has included a negative disbursement on Line 23 in the amount of \$1,000.

Thank you again for your assistance in this matter and in providing me with instructions on how to rectify the situation. I regret that the Winston & Strawn PAC unintentionally reported incorrect information to the FEC, and I am taking efforts to ensure that it does not occur in the future.
