Ms. Fleming,

This letter is the response of the DC Republican Committee to your letter of June 27, 2008. We are filing an amended February 2008 Monthly report concurrent with the filing of this letter to address the issues raised in your questions. The amendments are technical in nature and do not in anyway affect the amount of contributions or expenditures reported either individually or in the aggregate.

You ask for clarification regarding a receipt reported on line 15 from January 28, 2008 of \$256.00 from Cynthia Dillon. The memo noted the amount was for "payment for long distance/telephone." Ms. Dillon is the Executive Director of Republicans Abroad, a federal political committee that subleases space in the DC Republican Party's offices. We regularly report a sublease payment from Republicans Abroad on our FEC filings. The \$256.00 amount was a reimbursement for telephone expenses paid by the DC Republican Party but attributable to Republicans Abroad. The reimbursement was for the exact amount attributable to Republicans Abroad and there was no excess amount that could be considered a contribution.

The February Monthly report has been amended to show the \$256.00 payment was from Republicans Abroad and not Cynthia Dillon.

The report has also been amended to add the requested Schedule H1. The DC Republican Party has been using the required 28% allocation ratio already so no further substantive changes are required as a result of this amendment.

We believe this fully resolves the questions raised in your letter. Please contact us if we can be of additional assistance.
