
This letter is in response to your letter dated December 13, 1995, that addresses the reporting of administrative expenses on line 21b of the Mid-Year (1/1/95 - 6/30/95) report.

GOP-5 is a relatively small PAC. We meet approximately 9 or 10 times a year. The PAC is comprised of people that volunteer their time when needed. GOP-5 has no office or office staff, no paid employees, and no telephone service. We work out of our own homes and the address listed for treasurer is my home address. All of my paperwork (filings and records) are prepared by hand.

GOP-5 usually has one major fundraiser per year, and the remaining funds are raised by means of solicitations and small fundraisers (sale of mugs, ornaments, and raffle tickets).
