Dear Mr. Jones:

In response to your letter dated March 13, 2009 item 1, we have received the attached communication from Kevin Wiley, Treasurer for "Alaskans for Begich".

Chevron Employees PAC (CEPAC) contributed \$2,500 on December 5, 2008 to the "Alaskans for Begich" 2008 general campaign for the retirement of debt. As a result of your March 13th communication, we contacted Mr. Wiley and he advised that at the time of CEPAC's contribution, the Alaskans for Begich committee had sufficient debt to warrant our \$2,500.00 contribution. Mr. Wiley also informed us that he is amending the Schedule D Debts and Obligations section of their Form 3, to reflect that "Alaskans for Begich" did have allowable debts at the time of our contribution.

Based on the information we received from Mr. Wiley, CEPAC believes the debt retirement contribution is permissible and will, therefore, not take any corrective actions at this time to obtain a refund or redesignate the contribution. If however, your records still indicate that "Alaskans for Begich" did not have sufficient general election debt at the time CEPAC made its contribution, please advise so that we can take immediate corrective action.

In regards to item 2 on your letter, our contribution of \$1,000 on December 10, 2008 to "McCaul For Congress Inc." is for 2008 general campaign debt retirement. Schedule B Line 23 of the referenced report has been corrected and the amended report was filed on April 2, 2009.
