On November 17, 1999, you were notified that a review of the above-referenced report(s) raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act.

Your November 29, 1999, response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.


-You still need to clarify the corrective action being taken with regards to the contribution made to Ted Strickland for Congress. A review of the reports filed by this committee indicate that there were no outstanding debts at the time that the contribution was redesignated to the general election. Therefore it appears that you should redesignate the contribution to a future election or request a refund. Any refunds or redesignations should be disclosed as necessary on the appropriate schedules.

The Commission further acknowledges that you have sent letters to the remaining candidate committees to verify if any debts are still outstanding, otherwise you have indicated that the contributions will be redesignated to the 2000 Primary. You still need to notify the Commission of the corrective action that will be taken with regards to each of these contributions and amend your reports as necessary.

If this information is not received by the Commission within fifteen (15) days from the date of this notice, the Commission may choose to initiate audit or legal enforcement action.
