Dear Mr. Evans:

This letter is in response to your inquiry regarding your preliminary review of the above report. Your first question was about the \$19,142.43 disbursement to LUPAC- Administration reported on schedule B for line 21b. This disbursement is for administrative expenses of the PAC. A separate account for administrative expenses is kept per FEC guidelines. When the administrative account cannot pay for the admin. expenses of that month, a transfer from the political contribution account must be made. The Committee does not make any contribution to nonfederal campaigns, thus the disbursement is disclosed on line 21b. Transfers of this kind have been reported this way since the PAC's inception.

The second issue raised is the computer generated reports that have been used for many years now by our Committee. Per our previous discussion on this subject, we submitted a sample copy for approval by the Commission. We recently received written response by the Commission that these forms are not acceptable. To conform to FEC guidelines, we will begin to revert back to typing the information on to the actual report form. This will begin with the January 1996 report.
