This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:

-Schedule A supporting Line 11(b) of your report discloses a receipt(s) from the Bob Livingston Tribute. Please be advised that federal regulations require the itemization of all contributions from individuals/persons that aggregate greater than \$200 in the calendar year. If this figure includes any receipts that aggregate greater than \$200 from an individual/person, please amend your report(s) by itemizing the receipts on Schedule A. 11 CFR §104.3(a)(2)

-Your report disclosed a category of financial activity that has been reflected on the wrong line of the Detailed Summary Page. Transfers from affiliated committees should be properly disclosed on a separate Schedule A, supporting Line 12 of the Detailed Summary Page. Please refer to the instructions contained on the forms to determine the proper categorization when preparing your next filing.


-The coordinated expenditure schedule (Schedule F) should disclose the following information: identification of the authorizing committee, the payee's name and address, the purpose of the expenditure as well as identification of the candidate supported, the date and amount of the payment and the aggregate year-to-date total for each candidate supported.

Please amend Schedule F by providing the identification of the candidate supported and the purpose of the expenditure. 2 U.S.C. §441a(d)

-Your committee has filed a report that contains an additional Schedule H1 that contains the fixed federal percentage for national party committees. In states that hold federal and non-federal elections in different years, committees must complete an additional Schedule H1 to calculate the allocation ratio for generic voter drive costs. See 11 CFR §106.5(d)(2). Please amend your report by providing a corrected additional Schedule H1.

A written response or an amendment to your original report(s) correcting the above problem(s) should be filed with the Federal Election Commission within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter.
