
This letter is in response to yours of June 11, 1997, asking about: (1) contributions to Lampson for Congress which appeared to exceed the allowable limits and (2) administrative expenses for the reporting period.

(1) Elections for the Texas Congressional seat in which Nick Lampson participated and we contributed were as follows: Special Election on November 4, 1996 (due to redistricting that nullified the March 1996 Election) and a Run-Off Election on December 10, 1996. Our Committee's first \$1,000 contribution on October 14 was for the November Special Election; and the Committee's second \$1,000 contribution on November 21 was for the December Run-Off Election.

(2) The Committee still had no office and no paid personnel at the time this report was filed. Any administrative work (filings, deposits, FEC compilation) was accomplished by C&E Systems of Oregon, and expenses incurred in this regard did not exceed \$500 at the time of the FEC filing. Their services were invoiced and paid during the reporting period which followed thereafter. You will see them reported in the semi-annual report due next month. Also, an Executive Director was hired and other administrative activity took place during that reporting period and will be reflected in the semi-annual report.
