This Form 99 Miscellaneous Report is being filed in response to the June 6, 2013 Request for Additional Information (RFAI) from the FEC concerning Pfizer Inc PAC's 2012 Year End Report. Specifically, the FEC is requesting additional information with respect to certain debt retirement contributions made by Pfizer Inc PAC. After receiving the RFAI, Pfizer Inc PAC contacted the committees listed in the FEC's letter to determine whether the committees had sufficient debt at the time the contributions were made by Pfizer Inc PAC. Thomas Massie for Congress confirmed that at the time the contribution was made by Pfizer Inc PAC, the committee had sufficient primary debt to accept the contribution. Bera for Congress and Schneider for Congress confirmed that at the time the contribution was made by Pfizer Inc PAC, the committees had sufficient general debt to accept the contribution. Kaine for Virginia for Virginia and Donnelly for Indiana confirmed that at the time the contribution was made by Pfizer Inc PAC the committees did not have sufficient general debt to accept the contribution. The uncashed checks were returned to Pfizer PAC and was reported by Pfizer Inc PAC as a negative disbursements in its February Monthly FEC report. Friends of Dave Joyce confirmed that at the time the contribution was made by Pfizer Inc PAC the committee did not sufficient general debt to accept the contribution. The uncashed check was returned to Pfizer PAC and will be reported as a negative disbursement on Pfizer Inc PAC's August Monthly FEC report. Ted Cruz for Senate confirmed that at the time the contribution was made by Pfizer Inc PAC the committee did not have sufficient primary debt to accept the contribution. A refund check was received from Ted Cruz for Senate and reported in Pfizer Inc PAC's May Monthly FEC report. The contribution for Friends of Trey Radel was inadvertently designated to the 2012 General election. It was intended for debt retirement in connection with the 2012 Primary election. Pfizer Inc PAC will show a redesignation of this contribution on its July Monthly FEC report. Alan Lowenthal for Congress, Committee to Elect Michelle Lujan Grisham, Grace for New York, Janice Han for Congress, and Gloria Negrete McLeod for Congress have not responded to Pfizer Inc's PAC request to confirm whether their committees had sufficient debt to accept Pfizer Inc. PAC's contribution. Pfizer Inc PAC has requested refunds of the debt retirement contributions.
