
1. On Schedule D of your previous report, you disclosed a debt(s) owed to "The Driskill Hotel". This obligation(s), however, has been omitted from this report. Please amend your report to include this debt(s) on Schedule D and Line 10 of the Summary Page. All debts and obligations must be disclosed until extinguished. 11 CFR §104.11
2. Your report discloses an outstanding balance(s) beginning this period for a debt(s) owed to "Upstream Communications, LP". However, an outstanding balance(s) at the close of the period was not disclosed on your Amended 12-Day Pre-General (10/1/08-10/15/08), received 7/28/09. Please amend your report(s) to clarify this discrepancy.

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**
