Dear Mr. Walters:

On October 25, 2000 you were notified that a review of the above-referenced report(s) raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act.

The Commission is in receipt of your letter dated November 6, 2000 in which you address the apparently excessive contributions to Senator Frist. You also state that you will be amending Schedule B, supporting Line 23 to include the office sought for the candidates you contributed to. An adequate response must be received at the Commission by December 6, 2000. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement actions.
