This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 3 items:


1. Commission records indicate that your committee is a Leadership PAC; however, you have not checked the box on Line 5(f) which indicates that your committee is a Leadership PAC. Please check the appropriate box identifying your committee as a Leadership PAC on Line 5(f).
2. Line 5(g) or 5(h) of your Statement of Organization lists "Progress for Oregon" as a joint fundraising participant. In addition, Line 6 [ADDITIONAL section on page 5] lists "Progress for Oregon" as a joint fundraising representative. Please be advised that "Progress for Oregon" does not appear to be a registered committee with the Commission. Please amend your Statement of Organization to clarify your committee's relationship with "Progress for Oregon" and clarify whether it is a federal political committee.
3. Line 5(f) of your Statement of Organization indicates that your committee is a Leadership PAC; however, you have indicated "Jeff Merkley for Oregon" as the Leadership PAC sponsor on Line 6. Please be advised, Leadership PACs must identify their sponsoring federal candidate or individual holding Federal office, however, this does not include listing the authorized committee of the candidate or officeholder. Please amend your filing to clarify this apparent discrepancy.

**Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter.** Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
