
On behalf of KPAC (the "Committee"), I am responding to your letter of August 7, 2002, which the Committee received on August 15, 2002.

You, on behalf of the Federal Election Commission (the "Commission"), raised a question concerning whether the Committee fully disclosed all of its administrative expenses in the above-referenced reports. The Committee has fully and completely disclosed all of its administrative expenses. The Committee endeavors to minimize its administrative expenses so that funds raised can be used for its principle purpose. As such, the Committee out-sources most of its administrative, fundraising and accounting functions. When it has incurred fundraising expenses, those expenses have been fully disclosed. As an example, the Committee contracted with *Walden & Associates*, a Houston, Texas based fundraising group, to organize a fundraising event during the second quarter of 2002. You will note that these expenses were properly recorded on the July Quarterly Report of Receipts and Disbursements. It is also important to note that such costs are considerably less by not being based in the greater Washington, D.C. area. Finally, the Committee utilizes volunteers extensively to further reduce costs.

I trust that this response has addressed the issues raised in your letter concerning the above-referenced reports. The Committee is committed to complying fully with all of the requirements of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, and the rules and regulations of the Commission.
