Dear Ms. Manzano:

This letter is in response to your correspondence dated October 15, 1997, referencing a contribution to a candidate for federal office which appears to exceed the \$5,000 limit per election set forth in the Act.

We have reviewed our records related to the 2/13/97 contribution to the Enzi for US Senate Committee. Those records indicate that the contribution was intended to be attributed to Mr. Enzi's 1996 primary election campaign deficit. Mr. Enzi's committee was so advised at the time the contribution was made. We have also confirmed with Mr. Enzi's committee that they correctly deposited and reported the contribution in question as attributable to the 1996 primary election campaign deficit.

As a result, this contribution was, in fact, in all respects properly issued and attributed to Mr. Enzi's 1996 primary election campaign deficit, except that by oversight it was incorrectly described on our March 1997 monthly report as attributable to the 1996 general election campaign deficit.

To correct this inadvertent error we are amending the March 1997 monthly report to reflect the correct attribution of this contribution. Enclosed you will find page 1 of 1, line 23, item A to reflect a correction to our original filed report. All other aspects of the report remain unchanged.
