Dear Ms. Manzano:

In reference to your letters dated December 3, 1997 and December 24, 1997, concerning the Campaign For Working Families' (CWF) Mid-Year Report (6/3/97-6/30/97), please note the following responses to your comments:

1. In all CWF solicitations, a request for the contributor's full name, mailing address, occupation and name of employer is made. For contributors that do not supply all of the requested information, a follow-up letter, which includes a self-addressed stamped envelope, is sent to the contributor again requesting the complete information. Enclosed is a sample of the original request for information on the response card from CWF's most recent solicitation, as well as a sample of the additional information request letter sent to contributors who do not provide the information.

CWF's Year End Report will include all of the new information obtained in this regard that has not previously been disclosed.

2. CWF makes every effort to include all of the information required in Schedule D, and will include amendments for any information not previously included. In the specific case referenced in your letter, CWF will amend our report to note that the debt owed to EU Services was for "Mail production".
3. The total(s) to Line 21 (b), Columns A and B of the Detailed Summary Page were inadvertently left off of the report, instead being placed on line 21 (c). Since CWF has not had any Shared Federal/Non-Federal Activity (Lines 21(a)(i) and 21(a)(ii)), the amount on line 21(b) would be the same for line 21(c) and would not change any other lines on the report. CWF will insure that this is properly filled out in all subsequent reports.


