This letter is to inform you that as of April 11, 2001 the Commission has not received your response to our request for additional information, dated March 21, 2001. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. To ensure compliance with the provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act (the Act), please respond to this request (copy enclosed).

An adequate response must be received at the Commission by May 2, 2001. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.

Dear Ms. Eudy:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:

- Schedule D discloses \$21,805.25 in payment(s) this period to Custom Air Services; however, there are \$5,841.25 in payments reflected on your disbursement schedules. Please amend your report to clarify this discrepancy.
- Itemized disbursements must include a brief statement or description of why the disbursements were made. Please amend Schedule B of your report to clarify the following description(s): "consulting", "event expense" and "advance - consulting". For further guidance regarding acceptable purposes of disbursements, please refer to 11 CFR §104.3(b)(3).
- Please clarify all expenditures made for "media services" on Schedule B. If a portion or all of these expenditures were made on behalf of specifically identified federal candidates, this amount should be disclosed on Schedules B, E or F supporting Lines 23, 24 or 25 and include the amount, name, address and office sought by each candidate. 11 CFR §§104.3(b) and 106.1
- Schedule A supporting Line 17 of your report does not disclose aggregate year-to-date totals for other federal receipts. On future reports, please provide the aggregate year-to-date totals.

-It appears that the figures you have disclosed on Lines 21(a), 29 and 30 of the Detailed Summary Page have been inadvertently recorded on the incorrect lines. Please amend your report to disclose your figures on the correct lines of the Detailed Summary Page.

A written response or an amendment to your original report(s) correcting the above problem(s) should be filed with the Federal Election Commission within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter.
