This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **An adequate response must be received at the Commission by the response date noted above.** An itemization of the information needed follows:

-The outstanding balance of a debt owed to a creditor at the close of one report should be exactly the same as the outstanding balance beginning the period of the next report. This report shows a beginning outstanding balance(s) to "Pitney Bowes Purchase Power" and "Connolly & Goldian," which is not identical to the ending outstanding balance(s) for the creditor(s) on the Amended Year-End Report (12/1/05-12/31/05), received 2/16/06. Please amend your report to clarify the discrepancy.

-Your report discloses an outstanding balance(s) beginning this period for a debt(s) owed to "Creative Strategies," "Qwest" "Inc. Pacific NW Telco" and "Computer Village." However, an outstanding balance(s) at the close of the period was not disclosed on your Amended Year-End Report (12/1/05-12/31/05), received 2/16/06. Please amend your report(s) to clarify this discrepancy.



Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply

with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.
