This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action. Additional information is needed for the following 2 item(s):

- 1. Schedule B supporting Line 21(b) of your report discloses \$1,564.32 in activity identified as MEMO entries that do not appear to correspond with any itemized transactions. Please be advised, a memo entry is used to disclose additional information about an itemized transaction and the amount of a memo entry is not included in the total receipts or disbursements for the report. Please amend your report to provide clarifying information regarding this activity. (11 C.F.R. § 104.3(a) and (b))
- 2. Schedule B for Line 21(b) discloses a loan repayment to SHARRON ANGLE. However, the original loan has not been disclosed on your current or previous reports. Each person who makes a loan to your committee must be itemized on Schedule A and Schedule C. The itemization on Schedule A must include the person's full name, mailing address and zip code, along with the name of his/her employer, his/her occupation, the date of the contribution/loan and the calendar year-to-date amount of contributions made by the person. Schedule C must include any endorser or guarantor of the loan, the date the loan was made and all other terms of the loan. Please amend your report(s) or the applicable prior report(s) to disclose the original loan on Schedules A, C, and C-1 (if necessary) or to otherwise clarify the circumstances regarding this apparent discrepancy. (11 CFR §104.3(a)(4)(iv))

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due

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date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
