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This submission outlines the Committee's 'best efforts' to obtain and provide additional occupation and employer information for reports filed during the 2003-2004 election cycle. In January 2005, the committee changed officers and compliance staff. The staff that arrived in 2005 is not specifically aware of the best efforts practices of their predecessors during the 2004 cycle. In September 2005, the committee discovered that there were problems with the level of information provided in its 2004 reports with regards to occupation and employer. At that time, the committee resent written requests to all persons for whom occupation and employer had not been disclosed to the Commission on original or amended reports that requested the donor to provide the missing occupation and employer information without soliciting an additional contribution. The written request included a pre-addressed return envelope to further facilitate a response from the donors. The committee has also made follow-up phone calls to several persons who received the letters in September 2005 that requested the occupation and employer information. The committee amended its reports to provide information received from this mailing in 2006 amendments for each report. In the event that the committee has additional occupation and employer information that it has not yet provided to the Commission, the committee will file additional amendments for information received for 2004 reports.

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
