Dear Mr. Day:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **An adequate response must be received at the Commission by the response date noted above.** An itemization of the information needed follows:

-Line 21(b) of the Detailed Summary Page of your report discloses a total of \$0 in "other federal operating expenses." The sum of the entries itemized on Schedule B, however, indicates the total to be \$27,283.60. Please amend your report to clarify the discrepancy.

-The totals listed on Lines 30(a)(i) and 30(a)(ii), Column B of the Detailed Summary Page(s) appear to be incorrect. Please be advised that you should add the "Calendar Year-to-Date" total from your previous report to the current "Total This Period" figure from Column A to derive the correct Column B totals. Please amend your report and any subsequent reports that may be affected by this correction.

-Your calculations for Line 8 appear to be incorrect. Cash-on-hand at the close of the current reporting period should always equal the closing calendar year-to-date cash-on-hand amount. Please provide the corrected total on the Summary Page.

-The outstanding balance of a debt owed to a creditor at the close of one report should be exactly the same as the outstanding balance beginning the period of the next report. This report shows a beginning outstanding balance(s) to "Advanced Office Systems," "Paul R.J. Conolly" and

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"Conferencing Premiere," which is not identical to the ending outstanding balance(s) for the creditor(s) on the Amended March Monthly Report (2/1/04-2/29/04), received 12/9/04. Please amend your report to clarify the discrepancy.

-Schedule L-A of your report discloses one or more Levin fund donations from a person(s) in excess of \$10,000 for the calendar year (see attached). Please be advised that a State, district or local party committee of a political party must not solicit or accept from any person (including any entity established, financed, maintained and controlled by such person) one or more donations of Levin funds aggregating more than \$10,000 in a calendar year. 11 CFR §300.31(d)

If any apparently excessive donation in question was incompletely or incorrectly disclosed, you should amend your original report with clarifying information.

Please inform the Commission of your corrective action immediately in writing and provide a photocopy of your check for any transfer-out or refund. Transfers-out and refunds should be disclosed on Schedule L-B supporting Line 5 on Schedule L of the report during which the transaction was made.

Although the Commission may take further legal action regarding the acceptance of an excessive donation(s), prompt action by your committee to transfer-out or refund the excessive amount will be taken into consideration.

**Unlike previous election cycles, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered. Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.**


