
Dear Mr. Evans:

Pursuant to the attached resolution which was mailed to the Federal Election Commission in October 1994, Nathan Garvis was appointed Treasurer of the DHCitizen's Federal Forum at that time. Ann Barkelew is no longer employed by Dayton Hudson Corporation.

CONSENT IN WRITING BY CHAIRMAN AND TREASURER






