Dear Mr. Avella:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:

-Schedule H4 of your report discloses a disbursement to your non-federal account for "over transfer of non-fed share" for administrative/voter drive expenses; however, a review of your 2002 cycle reports does not indicate an over transfer of the non-federal share for this category of expenses. Please amend your report to clarify whether the non-federal account did indeed over transfer its share of administrative/voter drive expenses and provide the dates of the transfer(s).

-On Schedule H4 of your report, you disclose payments totaling \$3,836.61 to credit card companies for shared federal and non-federal activity; however, the sum of the memo entries supporting these payments total \$4,050.01. Payments to credit card companies must identify as memo entries, the original vendors from which you have purchased an item or service regardless of amount. In addition, the sum of the memo entries should equal the payments made to the credit card companies. Please amend your report to clarify this discrepancy.

-On Schedule H4 supporting Line 21(a) of the Detailed Summary Page, you have failed to include the total EVENT YEAR-TO-DATE amount for the "Direct Mail Feb 2002" disbursement(s). Please amend your report to include the missing EVENT YEAR-TO-DATE total(s).

A response or amendment to your original report(s) correcting the above problem(s) should be filed with the Federal Election Commission within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter. Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
