Dear Mr. Averett:

This letter is in response to your questions regarding the above-mentioned reports for Southern States Police Benevolent Association PAC Fund. In your letters you raised questions about the receipts itemized on Schedule A from Southern States Police Benevolent Association, Inc.

Southern States Police Benevolent Association, Inc. is a collecting agent for the Southern States Police Benevolent Association PAC Fund. These funds are transferred to the Southern States P.B.A. PAC account from the association. These funds represents voluntary contributions from our members of \$.50 per member per month. The aggregated total from any member in a calendar year therefore does not exceed \$6.00.

The amount of the transfers could be reported on line 11(a)(ii) since the aggregated total does not exceed \$200.00 per independent member in a calendar year. The periodic transfers from the collecting agent can be large during a reporting period; therefore, receipts have always been reported on Schedule A supporting line 11(a)(i). Each entry is documented to show that the total represents \$.50 per member per month. Although collecting agents need not be identified on the report, we chose to list the collecting agent in order to avoid any



confusion over the source of the funds (\$.50 per member), and to clarify where the funds are transferred from.

In the future, all receipts on Schedule A will also include documentation stating that these receipts are a transfer from the collecting agent. This should assuage the concerns raised by the Commission's preliminary review of the reports referenced.
