This letter is in response to your letter concerning the Amended October Quarterly Report (7/18/02-9/30/02), dated 12/26-/02, of the above referenced Committee. □

You ask about two 48-hour reports. Regarding the Massie contribution, the John D. Dingell for Congress Committee (the "Committee") received correspondence from the donors that they wished their \$1,000 contribution to be divided evenly between James Massie and Camille Massie. The Committee complied with the donor's request and amended its report to change the \$1,000 contribution from James Massie (reported on the 48-hour report) to a \$500 contribution from each spouse. Π

Regarding the Weiswasser contribution, the Committee received a \$2,000 contribution from Stephen Weiswasser during the 48-hour reporting period and reported it accordingly. The Committee asked if the donor wished to redesignate the excessive portion of his contribution to the general election or reattribute the excessive portion to his spouse. The donor chose to reattribute the excess portion to Andrea Weiswasser and the Committee showed the contribution on its quarterly report as a \$1,000 contribution from Stephen Weiswasser and a \$1,000 contribution from Andrea Weiswasser. This should account for the contribution that you do not see reported in the 48-hour reporting period.␣

You also ask about a discrepancy in the aggregate cycle-to-date totals of the Committee's itemized receipts. The Committee has reviewed its report and cannot find such a discrepancy. The Committee's database compiles these totals based on all the contributions entered for the cycle and all the data is entered accurately. Γ
