Dear Treasurer:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **An adequate response must be received at the Senate Public Records Office by the response date noted above. Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 2 items:

1. The election cycle-to-date totals for certain entries on your report indicate additional contributions that should have been itemized. When contributions from an individual reach \$200 for an election cycle, each subsequent contribution from that individual must be itemized, regardless of the amount. Additionally, each contribution from a political committee must be itemized, regardless of the amount. Please amend your report to correct the discrepancies in the aggregate totals for: AMO Voluntary Political Fund and Armstrong, Mickey. (2 U.S.C. § 434(b) and 11 CFR § 104.3(a)(4))
2. Your report discloses the receipt of contributions from unincorporated partnerships. Generally, these types of contributions are attributed to each person based on their percentage of ownership in the firm. However, any other acceptable formula may be used. Each person who has contributed in excess of \$200 since January 1 should be identified, on a memo Schedule A, by name, address, occupation, name of employer, amount of contribution, and aggregate total. (11 CFR § 110.1)

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.

A written response or an amendment to your original report correcting the above problem should be filed with the Senate Public Records Office.
