This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 1 item(s):

- The beginning cash balance of this report should equal the ending cash balance of your Amended July Quarterly Report, received 10/23/14.

The Commission notes the memo text included with your report which states, in part, that "[t]he Committee has identified uncleared transactions (e.g. checks that were not cashed).... Beginning and ending cash on hand has been adjusted in this Amendment to reflect all identified uncleared transactions."

Please provide any additional information regarding this discrepancy should it become available. (52 U.S.C. § 30104(b)(1) (formerly 2 U.S.C. § 434(b)(1)) and 11 CFR § 104.3(a)(1))

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**
